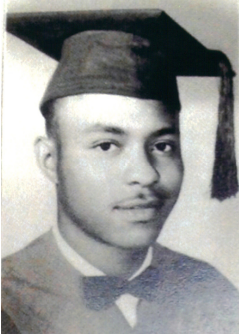


Terry Vernon Cooper
