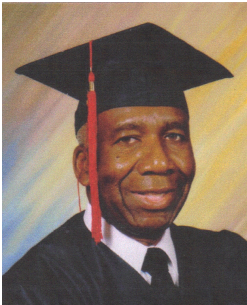


David Arthur Hall, Sr. was a Houston native who graduated from Washington HS in 1966. He started his track and field career at Washington and continued at Prairie View A&M.

At PV, he and his teammates won five championships. Hall earned a bachelor's degree and later returned for his master's and both mid-management and superintendent's certifications. At Lee HS in Baytown, Hall worked as a woodshop and welding teacher, as well as a track and football coach before rising to become one of the best high school principals in Texas. He retired after 35 years of educating and mentoring the youth and adults across the state.

Hall passed away in 2012 and is survived by wife , Dr. Dee Mattox-Hall, sons David, Jr. and Damon, three granddaughters, and mother Erma Cavitt and nine siblings.
